### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Please read this manual carefully and thoroughly before proceeding.
- For your safety, it is recommended that you wear safety glasses at all times during installation.

### INSTALLATION OVER CERAMIC TILES

- If you are installing the shower door over ceramic tiles, make sure that the tiles lay completely under the wall jamb.
- Use mildew resistant silicone to seal the gaps where the ceramic tiles meet the fixed panel.











### NOTICE

- Caulking is not required inside the shower, unless otherwise stated.
- Some models are equipped with clear sealing gaskets.

### CARE FOR YOUR SHOWER DOOR

- Do not use scouring powder pads or sharp instruments on metal pieces or glass panels.
- To keep the panels and metal parts looking new, occasionally wipe them down with a mild soap diluted in water.
- We recommend wiping the glass panels with a squeegee after each use.

\*When cutting the stainless steel header bar, make the cut on the side without holes to allow for adjustment.

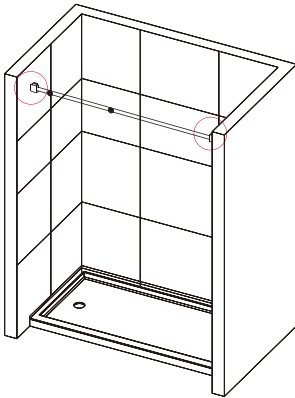


\*Disassemble the glass fixing fittings.

\*Insert the cylinder fixing blocks into the stainless steel header bar, ensuring that the holes align with the pre-drilled holes on the header bar. Then, arrange the fittings in order and secure them with screws.

\*Use a level to ensure the glass is vertically aligned, and mark the positions of the glass clamping holes with a marker.

\*Loosen the covers, remove the glass from the track, and place it in a safe location.

\*Use a 5/16-inch drill bit to drill 5/16-inch holes.

\*Insert anchors into the ground, align the clamps with the holes. Tighten them with screws, and then install the glass gasket.

\*Align the glass-holding holes with the header bar fixed panel brackets. Install the spacers, and securely tighten the knobs using an Allen wrench.

\*At the bottom, install the gasket and cover, then securely tighten the screws from the inside using an Allen wrench.

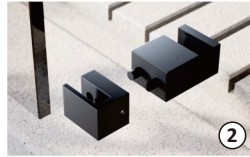
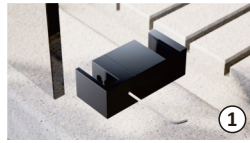
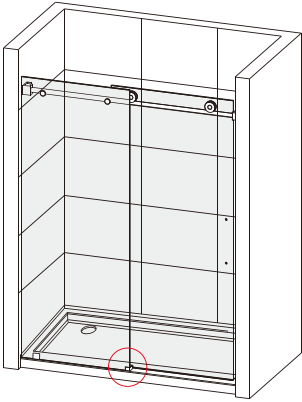
