GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Please read this manual carefully and thoroughly before proceeding.
- For your safety, it is recommended that you wear safety glasses at all times during installation.

INSTALLATION OVER CERAMIC TILES

- If you are installing the shower door over ceramic tiles, make sure that the tiles lay completely under the wall jamb.
- Use mildew resistant silicone to seal the gaps where the ceramic tiles meet the fixed panel.



NOTICE

- Caulking is not required inside the shower, unless otherwise stated.
- Some models are equipped with clear sealing gaskets.

CARE FOR YOUR SHOWER DOOR

- Do not use scouring powder pads or sharp instruments on metal pieces or glass panels.
- To keep the panels and metal parts looking new, occasionally wipe them down with a mild soap diluted in water.
- We recommend wiping the glass panels with a squeegee after each use.





STEP 1

Preparation



*Carefully inspect the condition of the wall before installation. Make sure the wall surface is even and smooth.



*Disassembling the Glass Clamp

STEP 2

Drilling the Wall and Insert the Wall Anchor




*Position the U-Channel and glass in their intended location.



*Mark the position of the glass clamps with a pen.




*Trace a reference line along the edge of the U-Channel to mark its position before removing the glass.



*Set the glass and clamps aside.



*Mark the drilling positions on the surface through the three pre-drilled holes in the U-Channel.



*Remove the U-Channel.



*Drill holes at the marked positions using a 1/4" drill bit.



*Insert the wall anchors firmly into the holes.

STEP 3

Install the Components



*Reposition the U-Channel and secure it with screws.



*Install the glass clamp bases and securely tighten the screws.



*Carefully insert the glass into the U-Channel. Ensure it rests against the gaskets, then reassemble the remaining clamp components.

STEP 4




*Finally, apply silicone sealant along the perimeter. Allow at least 24 hours for it to fully dry and cure, per the sealant manufacturer's instructions..




*Carefully inspect the condition of the wall before installation. Make sure the wall surface is even and smooth.




*Disassembling the Glass Clamp

STEP 2

Drilling the Wall




*Align the glass to the wall with disassembled glass clamp and then clearly and precisely mark the drill hole locations.



*Move the hardware aside and place the glass in a safe location.



*Attach a 1/4" drill bit securely to the electric drill.



*Drill carefully at the marked locations. When drilling into tiles, use a slow speed to avoid cracking.

STEP 3


Insert the Wall Anchor




*Insert the wall anchor firmly into the hole.

STEP 4


Install the Components



*Replace the components.



* Use a screwdriver to tighten each screw securely, ensuring they are firmly fastened.




*Slowly place the glass into the mounting slot. Ensuring the contact surface rests against the rubber gasket.



*Re-assemble the glass clamp with the remaining components and securely fasten onto the fixed glass panel.

STEP 5

Apply silicone sealant



*Apply silicone sealant along the edges of the glass.

STEP 1


Bottom Seal Installation




- *Install the plastic seal to accurately gauge the gap between the glass and the floor.
- *To avoid obstructing the doors movement, it is crucial to cut the bottom seal with precision. With an x-acto knife.

STEP 2

Wall Hinge Installation



- *Disassemble the hinge and re-assemble onto the glass door. Securely tighten with a screwdriver ensuring all components are tightly fastened.
- *one person must hold the glass against the wall while another person marks the drill hole locations for proper alignment during the drilling process, be sure to allow a half inch gap under the door for bottom seal clearance.
- *After adjusting the position, use a pen to mark it clearly and precisely, ensuring accuracy for proper alignment during the drilling process.



- *Drill the holes using a 1/4" drill bit on the marked spots, when drilling into porcelain tiles, maintain a slow speed to prevent cracks.
- *To install the glass door, apply masking tape to the hinge to protect its surface from scratches while installing the screws. Tighten each of the four screws individually, then remove the tape.

STEP 3

Fixed Glass Panel Installation



*align the u-channel and attach the plastic seal on opposite sides of glass. Adjust the fixed glass panel to align the top and bottom edges evenly with the glass door.


U-Channel Installation




*Ensure that the U-channel is level and parallel to the wall, then mark a guideline on the wall to retain the position reference for the glass once it's removed from the U-channel.



*Use a pen to mark each spot on the U-channel where holes will need to be drilled.




*Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a hole at the bottom mark, then insert an anchor into the hole.




*Align the U-channel with the drilled holes on the wall, and use a screwdriver to tighten each screw securely.


Wall Clamp Installation




*Position the glass clamp at the base of the glass in its intended installation spot, and use a pen to mark the placement for accurate alignment.



*Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a hole at the bottom mark, then insert an anchor into the hole.



*use a screwdriver to securely fasten glass clamp to the floor.



*carefully reposition fixed glass panel and re-assemble glass components onto the glass.

STEP 6

Door Handle Installation




*disassemble and re-assemble the door handle into position aligning to the holes on the glass.



STEP 7

Plastic Seal Installation



- *Install the plastic sealing strip at the junction where the movable glass door meets the wall, ensure the strip is applied smoothly and fits perfectly.
- *Once you confirm its proper alignment, use an X-Acto knife to trim away any excess material.




*Carefully inspect the condition of the wall before installation. Make sure the wall surface is even and smooth.

STEP 2

Install Glass Panel B2



* Disassemble the glass clamps.



*Check the total length of Glass Panels A and B. Verify accuracy using a tape measure and laser level.




*Position the glass clamps at the floor and wall installation points, and use a pen to mark the holes.




*Move the hardware aside and place the glass in a safe location.



*Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill holes at the marks, then insert anchors into the holes.



*Install the glass clamps and securely tighten the screws..



*Re-position the glass and re-assemble the remaining components. This completes the installation of Glass Panel B2.

STEP 3

Install Glass Panel B




*Position Glass Panel B parallel to the edge of Glass Panel B2.



*Position the glass brackets at the desired installation points and mark the holes with a pen.



*Move the hardware aside and place the glass in a safe location.



*Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a hole at the mark, then insert an anchor into the hole.



*Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a hole at the mark.




*Insert an anchor into the hole.



*Install the bottom clamp and securely tighten the screws.




*Place the glass back in position and re-assemble the remaining components.




* Install the top support clamp to stabilize the glass and ensure the overall stability of the glass panels. Use an allen wrench to secure it and make any necessary adjustments.


*Disassemble the hinges.



*Attach the disassembled hinges to the glass and securely tighten them with a screwdriver. Ensure they are securely mounted.



*Install the vinyl sweep to accurately gauge the gap between the glass and the floor.



*Ensure the bottom seal is positioned correctly.



*After adjusting the position, use a pen to mark it clearly and precisely, ensuring accuracy for proper alignment during the drilling process.



*Move the glass door aside to begin the drilling process.



*Drill the holes using a 1/4" drill bit on the marked spots. When drilling into porcelain tiles, maintain a slow speed to prevent cracks.



*Insert the anchors into the holes.







*Finally, apply caulk along the edges where the glass fixed panels meet the tile. Allow it to fully dry and cure, which usually requires at least 24 hours.

Unikoo's limited warranty extends only to the original owner/end-user, is for household use only (for commercial use please see COMMERCIAL USE section), and is not transferable to a subsequent owner. Unikoo reserves the right to modify this limited warranty at any time, it being understood that such modifications will not alter the limited warranty conditions applicable at the time of sale of the products in question.

This limited warranty extends for the designated period of time so long as the product remains in use in its original place of installation. This limited warranty applies only to Unikoo® products purchased from an authorized dealer in the United States or Canada. 3 Years Limited Warranty – SHOWER DOOR HARDWARE, TUB DOOR HARDWARE, AND SHOWER ENCLOSURE HARDWARE

The Unikoo 3 Years Limited Warranty covers all shower door, tub door, and shower enclosure hardware, with the exception of glass. Unikoo warrants shower door, tub door and shower enclosure hardware (i.e. handles, rollers, hinges, profiles, clips, guides, brackets, towel bars) in chrome and brushed nickel finishes only to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal residential use for a period commencing from the initial date of purchase by the owner/ end-user, contractor or builder from an authorized Unikoo dealer for the life of the product as long as the original consumer purchaser resides in the home in which the product is installed. THE WARRANTY PERIOD FOR ANY COATING ON HARDWARE IN SATIN BRASS, SPACE GRAY OR MATTE BLACK FINISH SHALL BE LIMITED TO ONE (1) YEAR.
